Energy costs increasingly influence the overall cost of production. Since the energy cannot be replaced completely, only one option remains - to optimize and streamline its use. Companies which that take this into account in their strategic planning reduce their operating costs usually within a few months or years and thus gain a significant competitive advantage. Energy-efficient technology should be a priority for companies, whose energy costs represent more than 3% of their production costs. This category includes many small and medium-sized businesses. Effective energy use in the industrial production can save in the short term about 10% of energy and another 15% can be saved in long-term interdisciplinary projects. Return on investment in energy efficiency and other processes are very quick. The measures taken often pay for themselves within the first three years.

The spectrum of measures ranges from simple structures organized independently to comprehensive energy efficiency projects, whose implementation requires a helping hand of the companies, providing energy-focused or advisory services. A conference dedicated to the possibilities of energy savings will present concrete ways to improve the energy balance of a company or a building, setting them in a broader technical, legislative and theoretical context.
